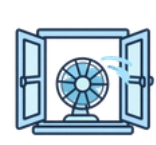
Line Up Small Items

After cleaning, furniture needs time to dry. Open windows for cross-breeze. Use a fan pointed at cleaned areas. Avoid sitting on freshly cleaned furniture until fully dry.
